Below we note some of the patent, malicious, and libelous comments made by you in your postings, based again on information provided to us by Mr. Kametler and Ms. Meyer.

1. Your blog postings consistently and erroneously accuse Ms. Meyer and Mr. Kametler of “the unlicensed operation of the Bed & Breakfast at 27 Oak Street,” falsely stating, for example, in the June 2, 2008 blog release that, “she and her husband have for at least seven years been advertising it as ‘24 Oak Street Bed & Breakfast,’” and falsely stating in the June 4, 2008 blog release that, “Carol Meyer, as recently as January of this year, was operating, without benefit of Village permit or Suffolk County license, their premises at 24 Oak Street as a commercial inn or lodging.” These statements are patently false and your several recent releases on this topic, which rehash old claims as new claims reflect your malicious intent. Ms. Meyer and Mr. Kametler have never operated, nor do they currently operate, a Bed & Breakfast at 27 Oak Street.
2. The picture of an outdated business card appearing on the May 24, 2008 blog release falsely portrays Ms. Meyer as operating an unlicensed Bed & Breakfast at 27 Oak Street. Ms. Meyer printed this business card in the late 1990's in contemplation of starting a bed and breakfast business, which was never actually achieved or initiated.
3. The June 4, 2008 blog posting states that, “Ms. Meyer charged a reduced rate of \$127, the maximum per diem allowable by the General Service Administration for the U.S. Government.” This, as well as any other related statement, is patently false.
4. The Statement appearing in the May 24, 2008 blog posting that “yet another Website [*hyperlink*] (see 24 Oak Street [*hyperlink*]) which not only advertised the unlicensed Bed & Breakfast operating at the home of Deputy Mayor Kametler at 24 Oak Street, but at the same time solicited customers for a potential over-crowding condition under Village Code” was maliciously made with knowledge of its falsity. Ms. Meyer and Mr. Kametler have never advertised 24 Oak Street as a Bed & Breakfast accommodation. Your hyperlinks are intentionally
